### Pocket Pistol

- start with pocket pistol loaded and on table, 5 extra rounds in cup
- at the buzzer shoot 5, reload, shoot another 5.
- three attempts, add all three, lowest total wins

### Derringer

- start with Derringer loaded and on table with 2 extra rounds in cup
- at the buzzer, shoot 2, reload, shoot another 2  
(hammer must not be forward on firing pins during reload!!!!!!)
- three attempts, add all three, lowest total wins

### .22 Revolver

- start with revolver loaded with 5, extra ammo on table
- at the buzzer shoot can until it crosses the finish line
- fastest time wins, any position can be used including resting on table

### .22 Rifle

- start with rifle loaded with 10 rounds, extra ammo on table
- at the buzzer shoot can until it crosses the finish line
- fastest time wins, shooting off hand only
